Band Award Jackets

We will be placing an order for letter jackets after the UIL Solo and Ensemble Competition in late February. Below is an excerpt from our band handbook on qualifying for a letter jacket.

Receiving a letter jacket is a visible indication of dedication to personal musical achievement and loyalty to the goals of the entire band program. All band members may be eligible to earn a letter jacket if they meet any of following requirements:

1. *Must be in band for (3) years with at least 75% participation in full ensemble UIL competitions. (Move-ins will still be eligible when they are seniors)*
2. *Make the All-Region Band or earn a 1st Division rating on a solo (or ensemble) at the UIL Solo and Ensemble Contest (TCGC for color guard).*
