Before You Get To School

- Complete your personal health screener via [Rank One Forms](#). There will be paper forms available at the entrances if you didn't check in with Rank One. **This must be done daily.**

What You Need

- Items to bring or wear
 - Marching instrument, supplies, music, and pencil
 - You will not be able to share or borrow any equipment or supplies
 - Rehearsal uniform - Shorts and shirt
 - Tennis shoes
 - Face mask/covering on your face
 - Band water jug, filled with water
 - Hat
 - Snacks
- Color Guard Specific
 - Hair up off face in ponytail or bun
 - No large jewelry
 - Towel

Entering the Building

Your temperature will be checked as you enter the building through the band hall. You must sanitize your hands as you enter the building. You must go to and stay in your assigned location (Color guard in dance room, Percussion in orchestra room, Winds in covered dining area) when you arrive. As a health precaution, it is imperative we stay 6 feet apart before and after rehearsal.



Schedule

Monday-Thursday

- 4:45 PM Check-in, sanitize hands, go to assigned rehearsal space
- 5:00 PM
 - Winds rehearsal in outdoor dining area for playing/Band Hall for marching
 - Percussion rehearsal in the percussion room/orchestra room
 - Color guard rehearsal in the dance room/band hall
- 8:00 PM Everyone must leave campus. Your ride must be in the parking lot and ready to pick you up. Students must maintain social distancing while waiting to be picked up. All areas used will be sanitized by DHS Band staff after students have left the building.

Additional info

- The August band camp is NOT required.
- As a health precaution, it is imperative we stay 6 feet apart and 10 feet apart when playing a wind instrument.
- The water fountains will not be available. You must bring your water and food.
- Restrooms will be available.
- Students must arrive dressed for rehearsal.
