### **Before You Get To School**

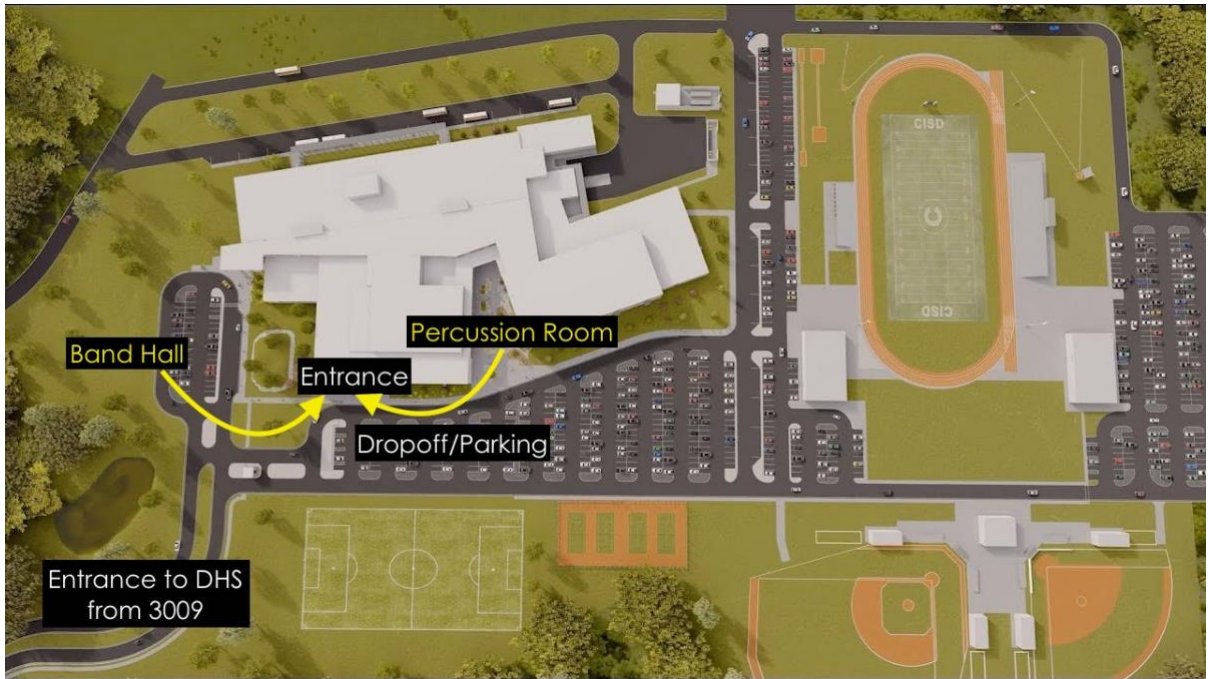
\*Complete your personal health screener via [Rank One Forms](#). There will be paper forms available at the entrances if you didn't check in with Rank One. **This must be done daily.**

### **What You Need**

- \*Your own personal pen/pencil. You will not be able to share or borrow any equipment or supplies.
- \*A filled, personal water jug/bottle
- \*Athletic clothing and gym shoes
- \*Face mask/covering on your face
- \*Color guard needs to have hair up
- \*Percussionist need to bring sticks, mallets, and all music

### **Entering the Building**

Your temperature will be checked as you enter the building. You must sanitize your hands before you enter the building. You must stay in your assigned location (Color guard in band hall, Percussion in percussion room) when you arrive. As a health precaution, it is imperative we stay 6 feet apart before and after rehearsal and 10 feet apart during each rehearsal.



## **Schedule**

Monday-Thursday

- 8:50 AM Check-in, sanitize hands, sit in assigned place
- 9:00 AM
  - Percussion rehearsal in the percussion room
  - Color guard rehearsal in the band hall
- Noon Everyone must leave campus. Your ride must be in the parking lot and ready to pick you up at noon. Students must maintain social distancing while waiting to be picked up. All areas used will be sanitized by DHS Band staff after students have left the building.

## **Additional info**

- The percussion and color guard camp is NOT required.
- The water fountains will be covered and not in use. You must bring your water.
- Restrooms will be available. It would be best for you to use the restroom before you get to school though.
- At no time will spectators/parents be allowed to watch or volunteer.
